GENERAL INFORMATION:

Booth fee: 10' x 10' space \$50, double booth \$100, plus 10% of total sales as donation to RLT

Because this is a fund raising event for RLT, **the booth rental fee and final sales donations ARE tax deductible** and are categorized as a donation. Hopefully this will also help keep booth fees really low and more in line with actual sales rather than projected sales.

Each artist will be responsible for collecting their sales, reporting their sales tax, and reporting their final sales donation. The booth fee only covers the space rental. We will not provide any set up items such as tables, chairs, etc. It is your responsibility to provide all you will need for your display. There is no electricity available for the spaces. A canopy is not required, but it is recommended. Once artists are selected, their art will be featured and promoted on the FB page and other social media. We will also tie into RLT advertising and event information. There will be multiple food truck(s), live artist demos, bands, and musicians.

Load-in begins at 8am. Load-out begins at 5pm sharp and must be completed by 7pm. We have volunteers on site to help you if you need. They will be available from load-in to load-out and will also be available for booth sitting to give people a bathroom or food break.

NOTICE:

As this is a family-friendly event art that exhibits nudity, bondage, violence or cruelty will not be allowed. The promoters of the show reserve the right to have any material that they deem questionable to be removed.

2 IMPORTANT ANNOUNCEMENTS

1. After the huge success of last year's competition - we're having a contest among the dealer's (participation optional). This year, we would like to encourage each displaying artist to create a **UNIQUE** piece of art – specifically for this show – with **GARDEN as the theme**. 2 awards and cash prizes will be awarded to the winning dealer (selected by the public and jury). The pieces will be displayed in a separate guarded tent, where the public can see and judge the items. The items can be marked for sale or not. Several artists sold their pieces last year. Awards and prizes will be awarded to the winning artists (selected by the public and jury).

2. The City of Raleigh has started a reconstruction process of the drainage system for the Raleigh Rose Garden. It was slated to begin last fall but has been rescheduled several times.

The plan at this point is to locate the artist booths, judging booths, food trucks and entertainers/musicians to the large parking lot adjacent to the RLT Amphitheater.

- Booths will still be 10x10 with spacious placement
- Food trucks and musicians will still be available and performing
- There is still complete access to walk among the roses and the garden will be open and blooming
- We will still have volunteers to help
- Most of the parking lot is shaded and this location will be considerably easier for load-in and load-out
- Bathrooms and concessions will be much closer
- Load-in will begin at 8am
- Show hours 10am-5pm
- Load-out must be completed by 7pm
